Transit of UAE

Transit Visa

Here is everything you need to know about applying for a Tourist Visa (short, long, single entry or multiple entry).

Mandatory requirements

Completed application form

6x6cm photograph in color (minimum of 600x600 pixels) with a white background (at least 80% of your face should be visible)

Color copy of your passport showing your full name, nationality, date and place of birth, passport number, date of issue and expiry, name of father / legal guardian, and the name of your mother

Valid passport with at least six months validity at the time of travel

Confirmed ticket travelling into Abu Dhabi Airport and onwards from Abu Dhabi to a third destination

Children

In addition to the mandatory requirements listed above, you must also submit a birth certificate for your child, in English or Arabic. Translated documents should be attested on the front page.

Dependents

Dependents are defined as a spouse, children below the age of 18 and parents above the age of 60. You must submit supporting documents that prove the status of the relationship, for example, marriage certificate or birth certificate.

Minors (under 18 years old)

For minors, including married females under the age of 18:

Photo ID of parents or husband is required

Copy of the host's passport or residence visa (this is the person with whom you will be staying in the UAE)

Females under the age of 18 or students must travel with their parents

Only machine-readable passports will be accepted (handwritten passports will not be accepted)

Submitting your visa application

Documents must be submitted in JPEG format only and must not exceed 1 MB.

Additional documents

Depending on your nationality, you may be requested to provide additional documents in support of their visa application. If these documents cannot be provided, the visa application may be rejected. The visa fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

Transit & Transshipment in UAE

Goods in transit

Imported goods from outside the country for the interest of a foreign importer addressed in his name or the name of a licensed agent carrier by a competent authority on the importer's behalf. The goods shall only be registered since transiting the territories of the country to a final destination. A deposit amount equivalent to the total value of goods shall be collected to ensure exit of goods outside the country within 30 days from the transactional processing date.

Transactional processing:

Receive and check documents for customs declaration processing.

Collect registration fees and deposit amount if in cash.

Deliver client's own copies and retain customs.

Documents required for transactional processing:

Delivery order from the shipping agent addressed in the name of the foreign importer or his carrier agent licensed by local authorized licensing agencies in UAE

Copy of the sale invoice from the exporter addressed in the name of the foreign importer showing total quantity, description of goods and detailed and total value of each item.

Detailed packing list as per weight, method of packing and HS code for each individual article contained in the shipment.

Transshipment

Imported goods from outside the country for the interest of a foreign importer addressed in his name or the name of a licensed agent carrier by a competent authority on the importer's behalf. The goods shall only be registered since transiting the territories of the country or exiting the customs arrival zone to the final destination.
